Dear Editor

Two weeks ago 12,000 people in Pembrokeshire voted for a party opposed to the new European constitution (Conservatives); another 5,000 voted for a party who oppose the European Union altogether (UKIP).

The Pembrokeshire results broadly mirrored those from right across the UK. If there is one clear message to take from the European election results then it is that a majority of British people do not support further transfers of power to Europe.

And what was Tony Blair's response? In the face of public opinion he flew to Brussels to sign a constitution which creates a new European President, European Foreign Minister and Charter of Fundamental Rights, and strengthens the European Parliament over the individual member states.

If Mr Blair had any respect for the people of this country he would have said "No" to the constitution and would instead be fighting to bring powers back to the UK.
